

Rock Lake Boosters 2020 Coyote Hunt Rules & Regulations

*Each team member will be in a drawing for a \$200 gift card on Friday, February 14 just after registration ends at around 8PM.

**Each team member checking in on Saturday, February 15 with or without coyotes will be in a drawing for a rifle to be drawn at 8PM

***Each team member presenting coyotes for check-in on Sunday, February 16 will be entered into a drawing for a rifle.

**** All winners of the above prizes **MUST** claim prize within 60 days or forfeit the prize. Check with Gerald Stenson to make sure you're entered into these drawings **PRIOR** to the drawing. **MUST BE PRESENT TO WIN ON ALL DRAWINGS.**

- 1.) All teams must register Friday, February 14, from 5-8 pm at the old school.
- 2.) Start time for hunt is 6:00 AM Saturday, February 15.
- 3.) Blocks will be handed out at registration on Friday, February 14 from 5-8 pm at the old school. Blocks cost \$10 per package of 10. Your \$10 will be refunded if you return your unused blocks after the event is over.
- 4.) All coyotes must be blocked in mouth with time and date of kill, Team Number and Coyote Sequence number. Cell phone photo of properly blocked coyote must be taken immediately upon kill and shown when coyote turned in. *Shooter of coyote must be in picture. We must be able to clearly read all above data fields written on the block in the picture you take.*
- 5.) 1 or 2 person teams allowed. ONLY 1 vehicle per team.
- 6.) Chasing or harassing of coyotes using ATV, vehicle, airplane, drone, snowmobiles, or other means IS NOT ALLOWED AND WILL BE GROUNDS FOR DISQUALIFICATION FROM THIS AND FUTURE EVENTS. We are a small community and will hear from our neighbors if you attempt this.
- 6a.) Teams **WILL NOT** be disqualified from the event if they produce coyotes that are not accepted due to factors unrelated to rule #6 above.
- 7.) No dogs allowed for any purposes during the hunt.
- 8.) Electronic or mouth calls are allowed.
- 9.) All coyotes may be harvested with any legal weapon. No trapping or snares.
- 10.) All coyotes (from Saturday hunt) to be checked in Saturday evening, February 15, starting at 6:00 PM until 7:30 PM (cell phone time). **ONLY ONE CHECK-IN TIME PER TEAM PER DAY IS ALLOWED.**
- 11.) Core temps of all coyotes will be taken.
- 12.) No pooling of coyotes between teams will be allowed.
- 13.) All coyotes become the property of Rock Lake Boosters.
- 14.) All hunters must have proper hunting licenses and follow all North Dakota Game and Fish rules and regulations. Local North Dakota Game and Fish wardens will be at the hunt again this year.
- 15.) Rock Lake Boosters will have final say on all matters regarding rules and regulations.

- 16.) Winners to be declared by total number of coyotes with ties to be decided by weight. If weight is also a tie then check-in time decides winner.
- 17.) Final check in time, for coyotes harvested since 7:30 PM Saturday February 15, is 12:00 PM (cell phone time) Sunday, February 16 at the old school.
- 18.) All coyotes to be taken to West door of school to be checked-in. Look for the sign on door.
- 19.) All members of team must be available via cell phone or in person to answer any questions.
